As each phase of this pandemic develops, we remain committed to learning as much as possible so that we can help our families and our students. We attend bi-weekly meetings with the Chester County Health Department, gathering information that we find helpful for our school community. Most recently, the discussion was surrounding pediatric vaccinations. We would like to share the following:

- 1. Vaccinations for 5 to 11 year olds are not required at this time. We understand that everyone is making a personal decision that is right for their family. We ask that you speak with your child(ren) about pediatric vaccinations and the personal decision making that goes into it. As you know it can be a very polarizing topic, and we would prefer that students turn to you for questions and concerns.
- Students will be excused from school for vaccinations. We ask that you try your best to schedule them outside of the academic day, but as we saw with adult vaccinations, scheduling will require some flexibility.
